In the field of Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Joe has, in the past 25 years, acted as Arbitrator, Adjudicator, Conciliator, Standing Conciliator, Mediator and Expert Determiner on a variety of disputes in Ireland, the UK, and the Middle East.

In Ireland, he sits on many professional ADR Panels of arbitrators, adjudicators, conciliators and mediators for bodies such as the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb), Law Society, Engineers Ireland, Construction Industry Federation, Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (CEDR), Single Electricity Market (SEMO) where he also sits as Chairperson of their two Dispute Resolution Panels and formerly the Private Residential Tenancies Board and MII.

He is a Member of the Environmental Facilitation and Mediator Panel for CIArb.
