## **REFUNDS**

Examination fees cannot be transferred to another sitting of this examination. *A refund of examination fees will only be given to candidates who produce medical evidence (i.e. a medical certificate from a GP or consultant) for non-attendance.* No refund will be given if a candidate is present for the examination/logs on to the examination, regardless of whether any of the examination questions were attempted.
