- TP DIRECTIVE: ACCESS TO LABOUR MARKET SUBJECT TO RULES APPLICABLE TO PROFESSION (ART. 12)
- COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION ON RECOGNITION OF UKRAINIAN QUALIFICATIONS – COM 2022/554, 5 APRIL 2022
- LISBON RECOGNITION CONVENTION – ARTICLE 7: “ALL FEASIBLE AND REASONABLE STEPS ... TO DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO ASSESS FAIRLY ... DISPLACED PERSONS ...FULFIL REQUIREMENT FOR ACCESS TO ...EMPLOYMENT ACTIVITIES” (EVEN WHERE DOCUMENTARY DEFICIT)
